

14 DAY HEAD LICE ELIAMINATION PLAN





MISSION:

Get rid of all **adult** lice and eggs





ADULT LICE

EGGS

MISSION NOTES:

During the first 4 days it is important to use the V-Comb daily to get rid of all adult lice and eggs from the hair. Leaving lice behind will lead to a reinfestation as a single adult female louse can lay up to 8-10 eggs daily over approximately 14 days. (Up to 150 eggs in their lifetime!)

PHASE TWO

MISSION:

Get rid of newly hatched nymphs or eggs that might have been missed





NYMPHS

EGGS

MISSION NOTES:

Eggs (nits) hatch 6 -10 days after being laid. Newly hatched lice (nymphs) are small and often difficult to see in the hair. Use the V-Comb 2-3 times during this phase to ensure nymphs are removed from the hair before they reach maturity and start laying eggs.

PHASE THREE

MISSION:

Prevent reinfestation



NEW ADULT LICE

MISSION NOTES:

Continue to use the V-Comb after school to check for lice. Avoid sharing personal items that come in contact with your hair like combs, hair accessories or hats. Head lice can be transferred through these items or through direct head-to-head contact. (E.g. hugging, leaning in to take a selfie.)

ADULT LOUSE ABOUT THE SIZE OF A SESAME SEED

POST MISSION:

Continue to use the V-Comb 1-2 times a week to check for new head lice activity and remove new lice to prevent reinfestation.
